ATISN 13494 Tuberculosis test notice and TB testing in cattle

Thank you for your request which I received on 15 October 2019.

You asked for details regarding any information held by the Welsh Government (including agencies) in relation to the production of Tuberculosis Test Notice of 14 November 2018. In particular, information relating to its calculation of the dates of:

1. 12 January 2019 (as the earliest date a TB test can be started); and
2. 13 March 2019 (as the date before which the TB test must be completed).

This request would relate to TB testing of cattle on the National Trust's holding at Hafod y Llan, Nantgwynant, Caernarfon, LI55 4NL.
