ATISN 13576 – Use of Locked Rehabilitation Services

Thank you for your correspondence received on 11 November to which we are responding as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000). We have interrupted your requested as follows:

The latest figures for the following if possible please:

- *How many Welsh clients were sent to a locked rehab?*
- *How many Welsh clients were sent to an open rehab?*
- *If there has been a decline in the use of locked rehab?*
- *If there has been a decline in the number of locked rehab services available?*
- *Who is being sent to locked rehab? e.g. forensic pathway, personality disorder pathway, history of self-harm.*
- *Is there a need for locked rehab in Wales? Specifically South Wales?*

If you do not have access to this data, would you be able to point me in the direction of the organisation that would have this please, or of any reports that you are familiar with?

Welsh Government does not hold the information you are requesting, however information may be available regarding assessments and placements for 'open' rehab from the 7 Area Planning Boards that commission and deliver substance misuse services across Wales. Should you wish to contact the Area Planning Boards for further information, please see attached for contact details.

The request you sent me contains personal information about you - for example, your name and address. The Welsh Government will be the data processor for this information and, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation, it will be processed in order to fulfil our public task and meet our legal obligations under the Act to provide you with a response. We will only use this personal information to deal with your request and any matters which arise as a result of it. We will keep your personal information and all other information relating to your request for three years from the date on which your request is finally closed. Your personal information will then be disposed of securely.



Under data protection legislation, you have the right:

- to be informed of the personal data we hold about you and to access it
- to require us to rectify inaccuracies in that data
- to (in certain circumstances) object to or restrict processing
- for (in certain circumstances) your data to be 'erased'
- to (in certain circumstances) data portability
- to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) who is our independent regulator for data protection
