**ATISN 13857 – Request for recorded information**

Further to the letter that I sent to you, regarding your request which I received on **10/03/2020**.

I have established that the information you have requested is not held by the Welsh Government.

Information on sheep traceability is held in EIDCymru, but this is a movement database, its only function is to record the date and tag numbers of animals which have moved on or off a premise.

To confirm, EIDCymru will not show the number of flocks registered to the CPH, breed information or who, the official owner of the flock is. It, also, isn't possible to know about any animals born on that holding as they are not recorded until they are moved off the holding.

The Animal Plant Health Agency (APHA) may hold some of the information you have requested but they will require further information about the premises you are enquiring about, ideally the CPH.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
