Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) (FOIA) received on 06 July 2022. I interpreted your request as follows:

In relation specifically to WAST:

- The overall yearly budget allocation for the last three financial years for promotional activities for all campaigns.
- the name of the 'marketing company' that delivered such activities for each of the last three years.

Our Response

WAST have not received specific funding in financial years 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 for the purposes of promotional activity for communication campaigns. For financial year 2022-2023, a budget of £250,000 has been agreed to deliver a National Communications campaign for NHS 111 Wales for a six-month campaign. Following a procurement exercise, Cowshed Communications has been appointed to deliver this campaign and are currently working with WAST and Welsh Government colleagues to scope out a proposal with suggested channels to use.
