## **Request for Information – ATISN 17748**

Thank you for your request for information dated 3 May.

### **Information requested**

You asked how many roads across Wales the Welsh Government expects will drop from 30mph to 20mph in September?

### **Our response**

There are 69 sections of the strategic road network which will reduce from 30mph to 20mph.

Please contact individual traffic authorities for data on the county roads affected by the changes to the default speed limit.

### **Next steps**
