Thank you for sharing the WLIA for the Swansea Valley proposal. The document certainly provides more information that the initial WLIA, however, I have some real concerns regarding this assessment. I have listed some areas of concern below and also as comments on the enclosed attachment:

- I'm not aware that any consultation has taken place with stakeholders, for example, the Welsh Language Forum. No forum meetings have been held for over 12 months.
- The WLIA doesn't fully address the possible impact and therefore fails to offer appropriate mitigating actions
- There is recognition in the WLIA that the area is a linguistically sensitive area. I would expect a plan to look specifically at this situation and a report with recommendations to inform this WLIA. The process of safeguarding this area is incomplete

The Welsh government funding currently allocated to the Swansea Valley project forms part of the Local Authority's Band B funding envelope. Therefore, if the Local Authority was to determine that the project was not to progress, the funding in principle would remain allocated to NPT.

However, the Local Authority would need to submit a Strategic Outline Programme (SOP) variation, which would then need to be considered by the Education Investment Panel and the Minister for Education and Welsh Language. The revised proposal would be subject to approval of a three stage business case process.
