Thank you for your request which I received on 27 May 2023. You asked for the following information:

- Whether an application had been received by Welsh Government, for the change in use of common land to another form of use (ie Transport Hub) next to Junction 36 of the M4.
- If so, to share the application in full,
- If not possible to share, advise of the date of submission, rationale within the application, the plan for development and current status of application (ie is it approved?)
- Whether there has been any form of consultation with the public who use such common land for right of access, livestock grazing and recreation
- Whether Welsh Government issues guidance, policy or strategy for developers in choosing brown field sites first before green field sites?

I can confirm Welsh Government has not received an application to change the use of common land to another form of use at junction 36 of the M4.

Paragraphs 3.55 and 3.56 of Planning Policy Wales Edition 11 sets out National Planning Policy approach to development on previously developed land.
