There is no statutory requirement for the collection of this data. The accuracy of the data is reliant on the information we receive from local authorities.

You may wish to note the annual Pupil Level Annual School Census (PLASC) is collected on a statutory basis and includes data on federated schools across Wales. To assist you further, this latest data has also been enclosed to this letter.
