I have reached the conclusion that it will cost more than the appropriate limit established in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004 to consider your request. The appropriate limit specified for central government is £600. When calculating whether or not your request exceeds appropriate limit, I am allowed to consider the time it is likely to take to establish if we hold the information, locate the information, retrieve the

information and extract it. If these tasks are estimated to take more than 24 hours of working time, the limit will have been exceeded.

For (just) grants provided in 2022-23, any report taken from our finance system (SAP) would identify individual grant payments but not the overall award (and would consist of thousands of lines information). Separate information would then need to be produced to match business names and combined, this would then need to checked across Welsh Government – the time period to locate extract and retrieve would therefore exceed the limit.

When then considering grants for 2023-24 – this would require a manual exercise to be conducted across all departments in Welsh Government to locate, extract and retrieve the information they hold – further exceeding the time limit.

However, you may wish to note that Welsh Government does publish expenditure over £25,000 information which can be found here <u>Welsh Government expenditure</u> over £25,000 | GOV.WALES which may help with your request.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
