## ATISN 19203 - Co-opted Community Councillors in Wales (2017 - 2022)

## Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2023. You asked for:

- 1) The total number of community councillors who were removed from community councils in Wales during the term of office from 2017 to 2022.
- 2) How many were removed from their post under the Local Government Act 1972
- 3) How many members were co-opted in their place
- 4) How many of those co-options were made, despite the fact that the co-opted member had lost their post under the Local Government Act 1972

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.
