ATISN 19217 – snares video

Thank you for your request which we received on 26 October. You asked:

1. Did Welsh Government commission the video promoting the end of the use of snares and glue traps as featured on their twitter account page “Welsh Government Rural Affairs” from the 10th of October 2023?
2. What was the total cost of the production of the video promoted by the Welsh Government Rural Affairs department on Twitter on the ban of snares and glue traps?

Our response

The video promoting the end of the use of snares and glue traps was produced by the Welsh Government’s in-house communications team. No information is held on costs incurred. Welsh Government does not record staff time costs against specific activities.
