### **Request for Information – ATISN 20080**

Thank you for your request for information dated 11 January.

### **Information requested**

How much money PJA/Phil Jones was paid to lead and implement the new 20mph default speed limit?

How much PJA/Phil Jones is being paid to now review his own findings?

### **Our response**

Phil Jones Associates have been paid £75,000 for consultancy work on the 20mph policy over 3 years. A further £7,000 has been budgeted for Phil Jones to be a member of the review team.

### **Next steps**
