Requests

- Total cost of the helicopter chartered on 16 February 2024 for the use of the First Minister. Please also supply the details of why a helicopter was chartered rather than travelling by car, who made this decision and was a cost/benefit analysis done before taxpayer's money was spent on the helicopter? (requested 19 February)
- A list of all chartered helicopter trips taken by the First Minister in the past 12 months, including the reason for the trip and why public transport or the official car was not suitable. Please also include the total cost of each charter and whether the carbon footprint of each trip has been calculated and how it is justified due to, as he is fond of pointing out, the climate crisis? Please also list the occasions when the official chauffeured car has been driven to meet the First Minister when the helicopter lands. (requested 21 February)

Our response

In relation to your first request, we can confirm that the First Minister did not travel by helicopter. In relation to your second request, we can confirm that the First Minister has not travelled by private jet or helicopter in the last 12 months
