Thank you for your request submitted on 4 April and your chaser of 20 April, which I received on 22 April 2024.

Information requested

Your request asked for:

- All communication correspondence and meeting minutes to and from Lesley Griffith, Welsh Gov Minister for Rural Affairs relating to this "called in" planning application, between the 01/01/2020 to 23/08/2020.

The request you sent me contains personal information about you - for example, your name, mobile phone number and both home and e-mail address. The Welsh Government will be the data processor for this information and, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation, it will be processed in order to fulfil our public task and meet our legal obligations under the Act to provide you with a response. We will only use this personal information to deal with your request and any matters which arise as a result of it. We will keep your personal information and all other information relating to your request for three years from the date on which your request is finally closed. Your personal information will then be disposed of securely.

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, the Welsh Government does not hold any information within the parameters of your request.

For your information the Welsh Ministers did receive a call-in request in April 2018 and on 26 April 2019 the Welsh Ministers issued a non-intervention letter returning the application to Conwy County Borough Council to determine. As such the application was not called-in for determination by the Welsh Ministers. Conwy County Borough Council issued its decision on the 29 July 2020 granting planning permission, subject to conditions.
