Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information that has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) which was received on 15 May 2024 relating to Llais funding. You requested the following:

- *How much, in total, this organisation is costing the Welsh Government, bearing in mind that there are 100 members of staff who presumably also have offices.*

Response

I can confirm that Llais receive funding from Welsh Government.

Information relating for 2022/23 can be found online in their annual financial statement of accounts, though it should be noted that this was for only part of the year due to Llais coming into operation. Although the accounts for the financial year 2023/24 are currently being drafted, the grant in aid available for Llais is £7.303m.
