How much money has the Welsh Government given to Active Travel between 2007 to 2024.

**Our response**

The Active Travel Fund started in 2018.

Since then, the Welsh Government has provided £200,715,911 to local authorities through the Active Travel Fund. This amount includes the provisional figure for 2023-24, which is subject to change once all final claims have been processed.
