

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A55  
(BLACKBRIDGE I GYFFORDD 2 (CAERGYBI),  
YNYS MÔN) (GWAHARDDIADAU A  
CHYFYNGIAD TRAFFIG DROS DRO) 2024**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A55, neu gerllaw iddi, yng Nghaergybi, Ynys Môn.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd (ac eithrio'r rhai a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau brys neu ar gyfer y gwaith), beiciwr a cherddwr rhag mynd ar y darnau o gefnffordd yr A55 a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 1 i'r Hysbysiad hwn. Disgrifir y llwybrau eraill yn yr Atodlen honno hefyd. Ni fydd y darnau o'r cerbytffyrdd tua'r dwyrafn a thua'r gorllewin ar gau ar yr un pryd.

Caiff darpariaeth ar gyfer terfyn cyflymder 10 mya dros dro a dim goddiweddyd i ganiatáu ar gyfer gwaith confoi hefyd ei chynnwys yn y Gorchymyn, a'i disgrifio yn Atodlen 2 i'r Hysbysiad hwn, oherwydd mae'n bosibl y gall peth gwaith gael ei wneud o dan y cyfyngiadau hyn.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 5 Gorffennaf 2024. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaharddiadau/cyfyngiad dros dro yn weithredol dros nos (19:00 – 05:00 o'r gloch) o 5 hyd 18 Gorffennaf 2024, neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y cyfnod a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A55 TRUNK ROAD (BLACKBRIDGE TO JUNCTION 2 (HOLYHEAD), ANGLESEY) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC PROHIBITIONS & RESTRICTION) ORDER 2024**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A55 trunk road at Holyhead, Anglesey.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all vehicles (other than those being used by the emergency services or for the works), cyclists and pedestrians from proceeding on the lengths of the A55 trunk road described in Schedule 1 to this Notice. The alternative routes are also described therein. Eastbound and westbound closures will not be concurrent.

Provision for a temporary 10 mph speed limit and no overtaking to allow for convoy working is also included in the Order, and described in Schedule 2 to this Notice, as some works may be able to be undertaken under these restrictions.

The Order comes into force on 5 July 2024. The temporary prohibitions/restriction are expected to operate overnight (19:00 – 05:00 hours) from 5 to 18 July 2024, or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the period specified above it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work begins.

## ATODLEN 1

1. Y darn o brif gerbytffordd tua'r dwyrain y gefnffordd sy'n ymestyn o Blackbridge i Gylchfan Kingsland, gan gynnwys rhan ddwyreiniol y gylchfan.
2. Y darn o brif gerbytffordd tua'r gorllewin y gefnffordd sy'n ymestyn o drwyniad y ffordd ymadael tua'r gorllewin wrth Gyffordd 2, gan gynnwys y ffordd ymuno tua'r gorllewin wrth y gyffordd hon a rhan orllewinol Cylchfan Kingsland, i Blackbridge.
3. Y darn cyfan o Blackbridge.

### Y llwybrau eraill

1. Y llwybr arall tra bo prif gerbytffordd tua'r dwyrain yr A55 a rhan ddwyreiniol Cylchfan Kingsland ar gau fydd mynd ar Blackbridge, yr A5 Lôn Llundain a'r A5153 i ymuno â'r A55 tua'r dwyrain wrth Gyffordd 2.
2. Pan fydd prif gerbytffordd tua'r gorllewin yr A55 a rhan orllewinol Cylchfan Kingsland ar gau, y llwybr arall fydd gadael yr A55 tua'r gorllewin wrth Gyffordd 2 a dilyn yr A5153 a'r A5 Lôn Llundain i Blackbridge.

Ni fydd Blackbridge ar gau yn ystod y gwaith ar brif gerbytffyrrd tua'r dwyrain a thua'r gorllewin yr A55 ac ar gerbytffordd gylchredol Cylchfan Kingsland.

3. Tra bo Blackbridge ar gau, bydd traffig sy'n teithio tua'r gorllewin yn cael ei ddargyfeirio i Gyffordd 2 ac ar hyd Lôn Llundain i Gylchfan y Porthladd: i'r gwrthwyneb ar gyfer traffig sy'n teithio tua'r dwyrain.

## ATODLEN 2

Y darn o'r gefnffordd sy'n ymestyn o Gylchfan Kingsland i Gylchfan y Porthladd, Caergybi.

## SCHEDULE 1

1. The length of the main eastbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from Blackbridge to Kingsland Roundabout, including the eastern section of the roundabout.
2. The length of the main westbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at Junction 2, including the westbound entry slip road at this junction and the western section of the Kingsland Roundabout, to Blackbridge.
3. The entire length of Blackbridge.

### Alternative routes

1. The alternative route whilst the main A55 eastbound carriageway and eastern section of Kingsland Roundabout are closed will be via Blackbridge, the A5 London Road and A5153 to join the eastbound A55 at Junction 2.
2. When the main A55 westbound carriageway and western section of Kingsland Roundabout are closed the alternative route will be to leave the westbound A55 at Junction 2 and follow the A5153 and A5 London Road to Blackbridge.

Blackbridge will not be closed during the works on the main A55 eastbound and westbound carriageways and on the circulatory carriageway of Kingsland Roundabout.

3. Whilst Blackbridge is closed westbound traffic will be diverted to Junction 2 and along London Road to the Port Roundabout: vice versa for eastbound traffic.

## SCHEDULE 2

The length of the trunk road that extends from Kingsland Roundabout to the Port Roundabout, Holyhead.
