Thank you for your request which I received on 10 July 2024. You asked for the following information regarding the use of Facility Time by Welsh Government staff:

- the number of staff who have taken time during working hours to carry out trade union duties in the last three financial years;
- a breakdown of the total number of hours taken each year and the categories of trade union duties performed; and
- a breakdown of the total number of hours taken and the categories of trade union duties performed.

Our response

The WG has three Unions who represent our employees - Public and Commercial Services Union (PCS), Prospect and FDA.

We currently have 8.6 Full time Equivalent (FTE) staff as union representatives. In addition to this we have two employees from one union who are employed on facility time, who both work part-time. The number of hours per week they devote to union facility time, by union are as follows:-

PCS – 5 FTE Prospect 2 FTE FDA 1.6 FTE

Information regarding the number of employees in our organisation who are employed as accredited reps for their union, on a part-time basis and who are allowed a percentage of their work time as union facility time, is not available.
