- 1. How many private law cases have CAFCASS Cymru provided advice to the Court in the years 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 (year to date)?

- 3. Does CAFCASS contribute towards the costs involved in funding sessions at a Family Contact Centre/Family Time Centre?
  - a. If so what funding is provided?
  - b. Is this funding for contact time in both private and public law arrangements?
- 4. What was the CAFCASS budget in the years 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024?

## Response to parts 3 and 4 of your request

Part 3. Cafcass Cymru does not fund contact centres *per se* but does pay for referrals for supervised contact in Private Law cases when the Cafcass Cymru practitioner allocated to the case decides it necessary to help them complete their assessment, or if the Court orders a referral to be made. Cafcass Cymru will pay for a maximum of 6 x 1-hour sessions in any one case.
