Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn drwy arfer eu pwerau o dan adrannau 1(1), 2(1) a 2(2) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrrd 1984, sy'n dod i rym ar 18 Medi 2024.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw:

- i. gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd sy'n mynd ar y gerbytffordd tua'r gogledd rhag troi i'r dde i gael mynediad, ar y naill ben neu'r llall, i'r gilfan a ddisgrifir yn yr Atodlen i'r Gorchymyn hwn; a

**THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (SOUTHBOUND
CARRIAGEWAY LAY-BY ON THE
SOUTHERN APPROACH TO PONT ABRAHAM
ROUNDABOUT, CARMARTHENSHIRE)
(PROHIBITION OF RIGHT HAND TURNS AND
RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER
2024**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into force on 18 September 2024.

The effect of the Order is to:

- i. prohibit any vehicle proceeding on the northbound carriageway to make a right hand turn to access, at either end, the lay-by described in the Schedule to this Order; and
- ii. restrict any vehicle from waiting for a period longer than 2 hours at any time with no return within 1 hour on the lay-by described in the Schedule to this Order.

During a period of 6 weeks from 18 September 2024, a copy of this Notice, the made Order and plan, may be inspected during normal opening hours at Carmarthen Library, St Peter's Street, Carmarthen SA31 1LN, viewed on the Welsh Government's website at <https://gov.wales/road-orders> or obtained free of charge from Orders Branch, Transport, Welsh Government, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF10 3NQ, quoting reference number qA1491264.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds:

- a. that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; or
- b. that any of the relevant requirements have not been complied with,

that person may, within 6 weeks of 17 September 2024, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
