## **ATISN 20911 – VAWDASV funding**

### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 27 September 2024.

You asked for: the average length of funding offered for the VAWDASV sector from the Welsh Government.

### **Our response**

The information you requested is enclosed.

Most grant funding offered for the VAWDASV sector is for 12 months. This relates to both our Capital and Revenue funded projects. The duration of funding is confined to a specific financial year and there is no guarantee of any funding beyond that 12 month period. Grant applicants must apply each year, and successful bids are dependent on several factors. Each bid for funding is considered on its own merits and subject to our agreed bidding process.

Occasionally we have been able to award longer term contracts, for example for the Live Fear Free helpline for which we provided a three-year contract.

### **Next steps**
