Thank you for your request for information on 19 September.

### **Information Requested**

The total amount paid by Welsh Government to Bombora Wave Power including any outstanding loans and how many local jobs were created.

### **Our Response**

The only payments made to Bombora Wave Power from a Welsh Government source is the European Regional Development Fund grant issued by the Welsh European Funding Office, which totalled £13,447,144.49.

There have been no loans to the company issued from Welsh Government, but I understand that a loan was sought from the Development Bank of Wales. You might like to follow up with them to answer your question on loans. [This link](#) will take you directly to the contact details for them.

The operation created 20 jobs making it an important part of the vision to deliver sustainable growth and jobs for businesses in the renewable energy sector. These direct jobs are supplemented with jobs in the local and regional supply chain, I am unable to quantify the number of these jobs.
