## ATISN 22036 - Cadw Fees

Thank you for your request which I received on 21 October 2024. You asked the following:-

Are Cadw obligated to remit annual fees to the Crown Estates for leases on land, rivers, or other sites under their jurisdiction? If so, what is the cost of these annual fees?

The only relevant agreement held by Cadw where there is a need for payment to the Crown Estate is an ancillary agreement that is in place covering part of the Castle car park at Harlech for which Cadw pay the Crown Estate a current rent of £2,833 per annum.

I received a further request for information on 24 October 2024 where you asked the following:

Are the Council obligated to remit annual fees to the Duchy of Cornwall and Lancaster for leases on land, rivers or other sites under their jurisdiction? If so, what is the cost of these annual fees.

We do not hold the information requested which should be addressed to the relevant local authority.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
