When it met last week, ExCo discussed preparations for an incoming First Minister and a new Cabinet, and the need for briefings.

There are two briefing requirements which need your inputs please - can you please finalise your contributions for both by latest cop Tuesday 5 March:

## 1. First Minister briefing

- To support the First Minister in the initial days and weeks following appointment, an initial briefing will be prepared centrally (by Permanent Secretary's Group), with more detailed briefing following from the areas of the business over the subsequent weeks. As part of this, a document outlining the top strategic issues in CCRA is needed - issues that either:
  - $\,\circ\,$  require input from the FM before summer recess; or
  - $\circ\,$  require the FM to be aware due to their high profile or contentious nature.
- This document is to enable the FM to get a quick overview of the most pressing issues in his first week that he may wish to request further detailed briefing on or discuss with officials. It therefore needs to be concise the steer is 3-5 pages per Group. With this in mind, can Directors please add their briefing to the attached, combined iShare document (*'Incoming Ministers briefings 2024 FM'*) not exceeding 1 page for each Directorate please?

## 2. Ministerial briefings – incoming Ministers

- Ministerial briefings are to be taken forward by Groups and overseen by DGs. To enable portfolio briefings to be brought together when portfolios become clear, briefings covering discrete policy/ delivery areas are required. To ensure consistency across the organisation, a template has been provided, setting out the requirements.
- Portfolio briefings are not expected to exceed 20 pages, with a need to focus on the necessary early essentials/ what's needed in the first few weeks in post. With this in mind, can Directors use the template for their individual areas in the attached iShare folder (*Incoming Ministers briefings 2024 CCRA Ministers'*), not exceeding 3-4 pages for each Directorate please?
