Routine Briefing – Planning Casework – Allocation of Cabinet Secretary for decisions

- The First Minister is asked to agree the allocation of the following planning decisions to the identified Cabinet Secretaries.
- 2. Planning decisions are made by "the Welsh Ministers" although in the first instance they are made by the Cabinet Secretary for Housing, Local Government and Planning (CSHLGP) who holds the town and country planning portfolio. However, there are some cases where the Cabinet Secretary is unable to take the decision, either because of having a prejudicial interest in the case or to avoid the perception of such an interest. These cases therefore require allocation to an alternative Cabinet Secretary.

- 7. A court order, dated 30 June 2021, quashed the October 2020 decision of MS, the then Minister for Housing and Local Government, to refuse permission for the Cefn Fforest recovered planning appeal. The appeal relates to an outline planning application for the proposed development of up to 300 dwellings on land at Heol y Cefn, Cefn Fforest, Caerphilly. The court order also requires the Welsh Ministers to redetermine the appeal.
- 8. The redetermination was previously allocated to the former Deputy Minister for Climate Change so now requires reallocation.
- 9. The case should be allocated to for Climate Change and Rural Affairs.
