- Details on the costs of the report including the budget agreed, who authorised the budget, any additional expenses including travel expenses and hiring of facilities, expenses of those who conducted the report, the final costs paid to Climate Cymru BAME, and statements of accounts for the body that commissioned the report for the periods 2022, 2023 and 2024.

- The report was commissioned by Strategic Evidence Unit, in the Rural Affairs Directorate of the Welsh Government by open bid, the bidding document is attached to this email for your information.
- The report was commissioned from Climate Cymru BAME on 11 August 2023.
- The report was delivered to Welsh Government on 17 November 2023.
- Welsh Government does not hold any information on reviewing progress of the report.
- The budget allocated for the report was £4999. Climate Cymru BAME were paid a total of £4990 to produce the report.
- The specific budget request for this work was approved by the Director for Rural Affairs.
