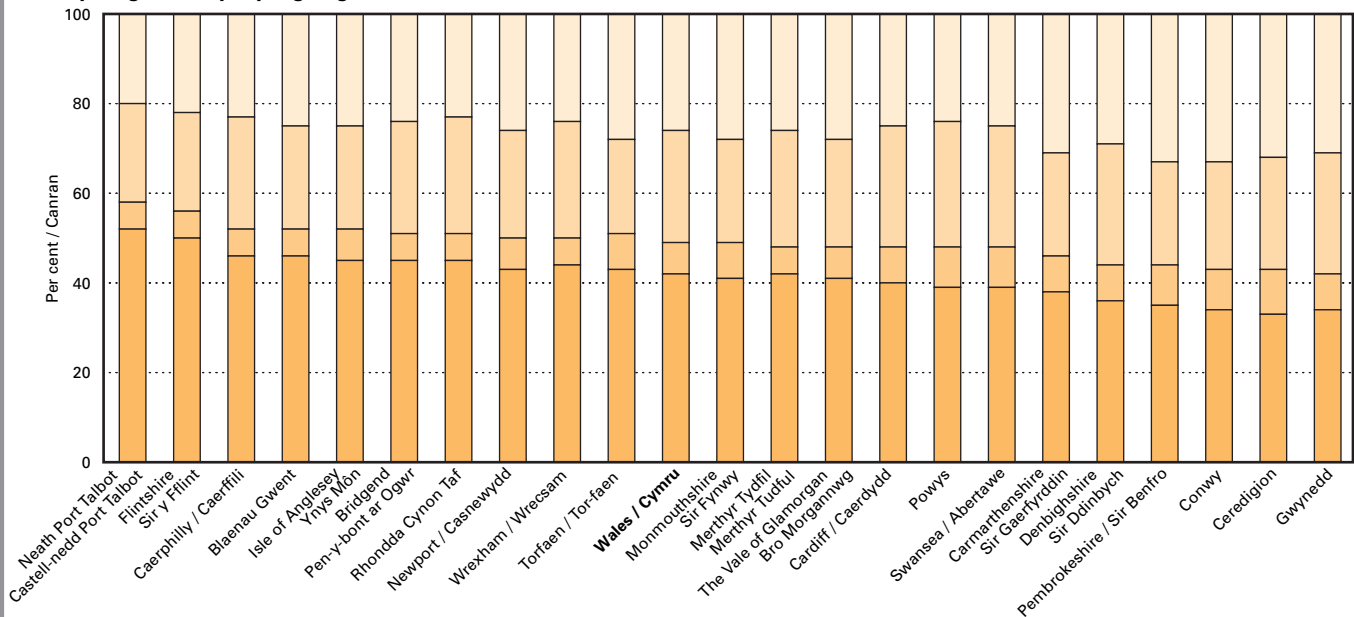

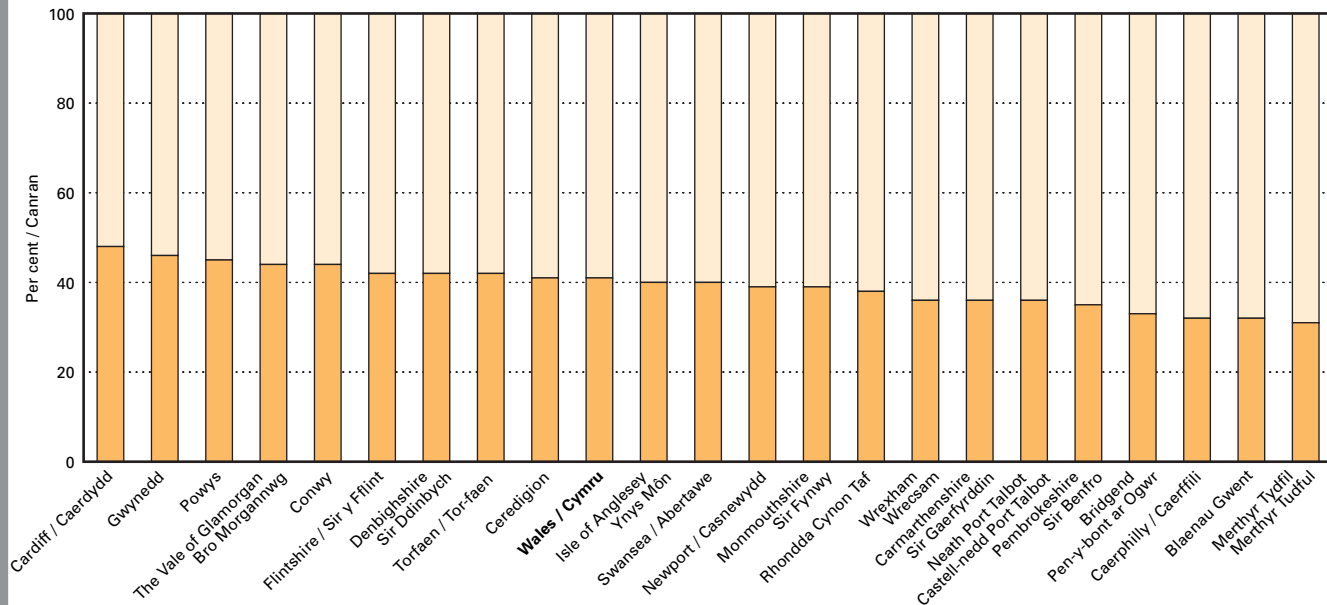

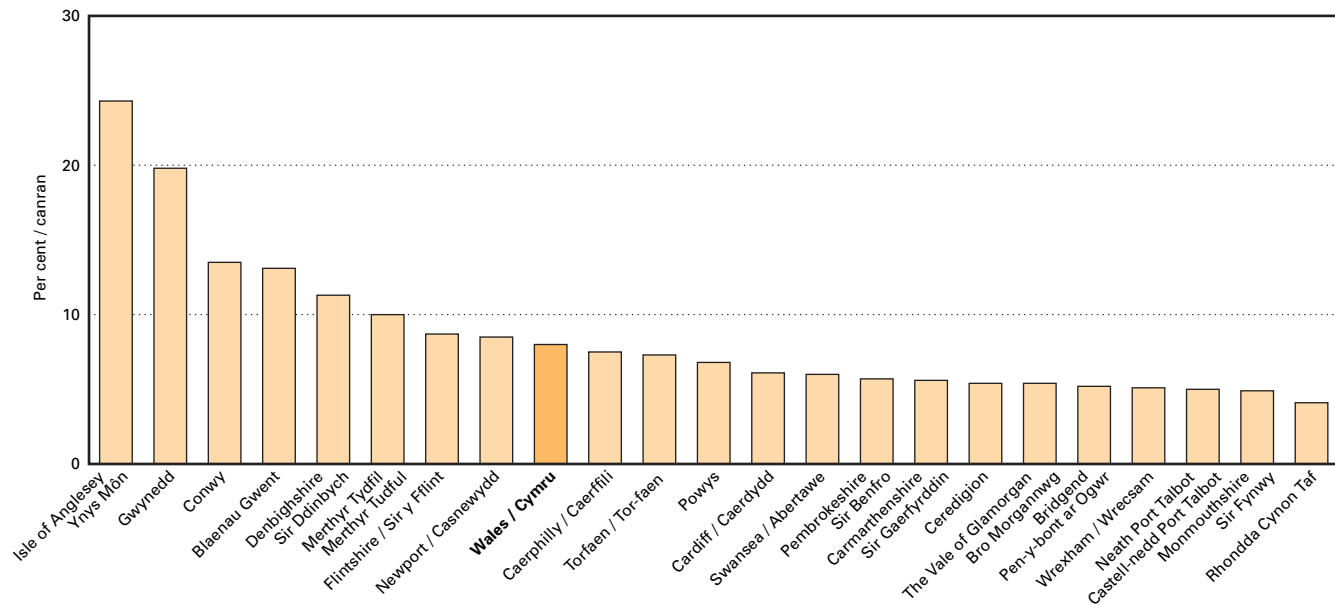

The data may differ slightly from published sources due to the inclusion of results from late returns to the surveys for each year.
